Your vote is your voice. Use it! Get registered and be a voter!

CAN I VOTE?

To vote in Minnesota, you must be a U.S. citizen, at least 18 years old on Election Day and a resident of Minnesota for at least 20 days. You must be finished with all parts of any felony offense.

WHERE SHOULD I REGISTER?

Register to vote using the address you currently consider home, according to the Minnesota Secretary of State's office. That may be your school address or a parent's house. If you only go back home to visit, it's recommended that you register using your school address.

If you moved to Minnesota from another state, you can vote here even if you pay out-of-state tuition or have a driver's license from another state.

HOW TO REGISTER

Visit mnvotes.org to register or update your registration before Oct. 16.

- You'll need:
 - A Minnesota driver's license or ID card OR the last four digits of your social security number.
 - An email address.

To register on Election Day, you must show proof of your name and current address. Visit mnvotes.org to find out what ID and documents to use.

HOW TO VOTE EARLY

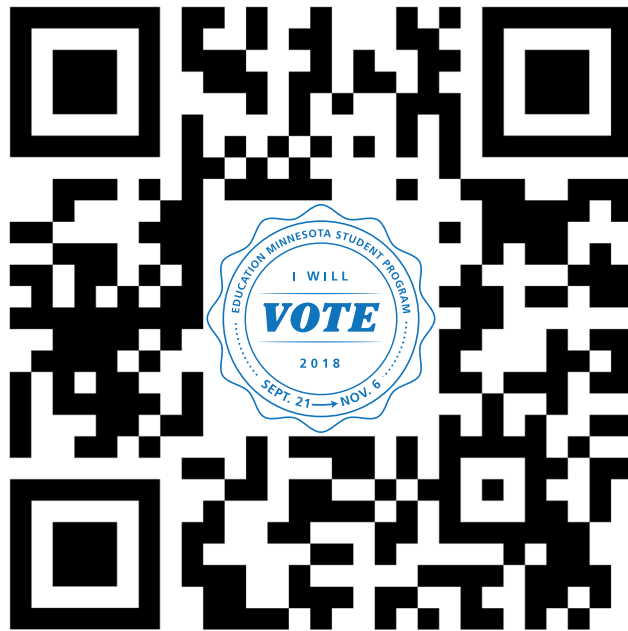
Any eligible voter can vote early at a local elections office. Voters can also apply for an absentee ballot to be sent by mail. For a list of local elections offices or to request an absentee ballot, visit mnvotes.org. Visit your home state's election website for an absentee ballot from that state.

WHERE DO I VOTE ON ELECTION DAY?

To find out where you vote, visit mnvotes.org. Most polling places are open from 7 a.m.-8 p.m. CT.

WHAT TO BRING TO THE POLLS

- If you're registered to vote at your current address, you do NOT need to bring identification.
- If you need to register to vote or update your registration, you must show proof of residency. To learn more, visit mnvotes.org.
