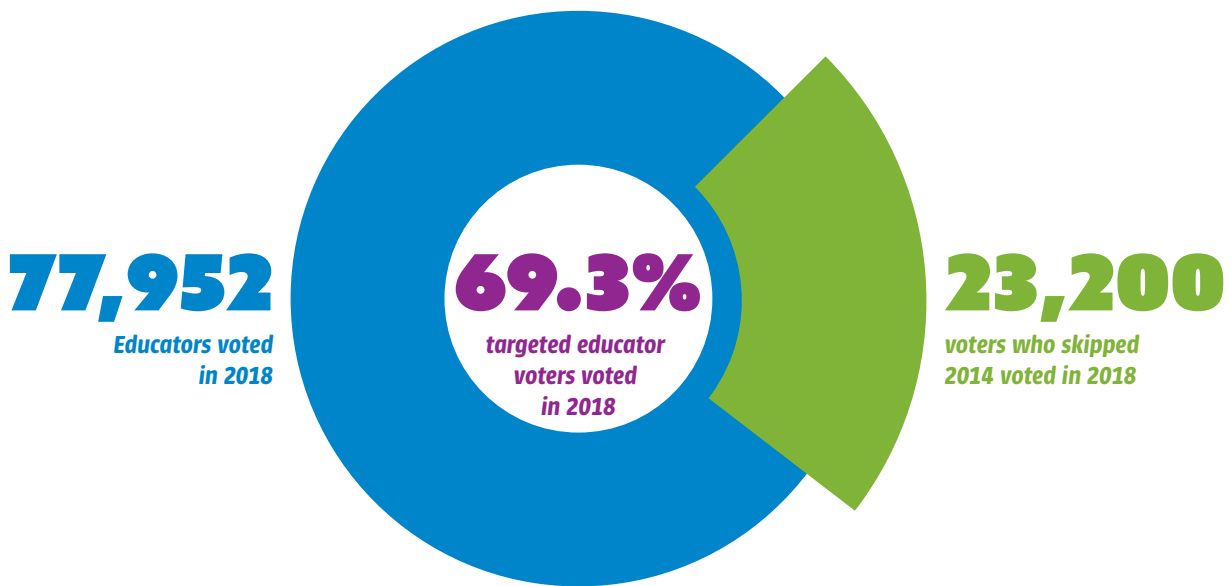




Results of campaign 2018

77,952 educators voted in the 2018 election, including 23,200 who skipped the last midterm election in 2014. 69.3 percent of educator voters targeted by our worksite action leader program voted on (or before) Nov. 6, 2018!

Here is our Minnesota plan for 2020-2021:

2. Collectively engage at least 33,000 parents and community voters in the election and beyond.
3. Unite our co-workers and communities in a statewide movement for full funding of public education in the spring of 2021.
