

Issue ID and build your network building meeting

Materials needed

- Access to Zoom, Google Meets or other virtual meeting technology.
- Paper to take notes or other visual aid.
- Building Meeting Powerpoint

Welcome

Welcome your members to the meeting. Someone record who is in attendance on MS Forms.

Intro

Explain the goals for the meeting:

- Determine the priority issues and concerns for your building.
- Begin to build your network to give you a voice in decision making.

Organizing Conversation and Questions

After each question:

- Allow participants a minute to think and reflect.
- Ask members to share out their responses.
- Ask the group to identify themes.

Question 1:

What most concerns you about your working conditions, and students' learning conditions, in the COVID 19 era, now that education is happening in your district?

Question 2:

What network do you have or can you put in place (both inside and outside of your building) for a rapid response around your priority issues or concerns?


Question 3:

What specific action steps can you and your colleagues take to make sure your working conditions and students' learning conditions are safe and equitable this fall? What resources do you have and what are your next steps if your voices are not heard?

Wrap up

Leave them with the reminder that members can have a voice in district decisions by organizing a powerful network at every building in the district.

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
