

REGISTERING TO VOTE IS EASY

In Minnesota, you can register to vote online, by submitting a paper application or in person on Election Day. To avoid wait times at the polls, it's best to register in advance. Advance registration closes on Oct. 18 online and by mail. After that, you would need to register at your polling location when you go vote.

Register online or download a paper application at www.sos.state.mn.us/elections-voting/register-to-vote.

Eligibility

You can register to vote in Minnesota if you are:

- A U.S. citizen.
- At least 18 years old on Election Day.
- A resident of Minnesota for at least 20 days.
- Finished with all part of any felony sentence.

Registered before? You'll need to register again if you:


- Moved to a new address.
- Changed your address.
- Have not voted at least once in the last four years.

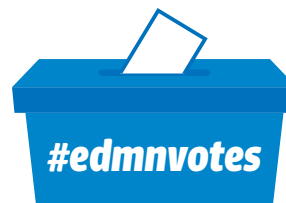
To register, you'll need:

- A Minnesota driver's license or identification card OR the last four digits of your Social Security number.
- An email address (to register online only).
- Proof of residency (for same-day registration only).
